Current Work Program

- 16 Active Plan Amendments/Studies which includes:
 - McLean CBC Study
 - West Falls Church TSA Study
 - Reston Study
 - Airport Noise Policy (countywide)
 - Housing Workforce Dwelling Units Policy (countywide)
 - Two Historic Overlay Districts (Mount Vernon and Providence)
- 10 Inactive/Deferred
- 5 Anticipated to be Rescinded
- Staff support not yet authorized (examples)
 - Lorton Visioning
 - Active Transportation (countywide)
 - Housing Preservation (countywide)

SSPA – South County and North County

- South County Cycle: Mason, Lee, Mount Vernon Districts
 - Anticipate between 9-15 nominations likely to be included on 2021 work program
 - Planning Commission public hearings in November
 - Board of Supervisors Action Item in January 2021
- SSPA Process Retrospective: Late Summer 2021 Dec 2021/Jan 2022

- North County Cycle Need to shift schedule due to COVID
 - Begin after retrospective- early 2022

Anticipated 2021 Work Program

Ongoing/Anticipated Completion

- Completion of Fair Oaks Mall, North Gateway amendments in 2020
- Completion of McLean CBC, West Falls Church TSA studies 1st Q 2021
- Reston staffed by Urban Centers with Planning Division support
- Two HODs Hollin Hills and Holmes Run Acres
- Policy: Airport Noise, Public Facilities, Housing

New/Move to Active

- 9-15 South County SSPA nominations
- Resume Fairfax Center Area Phase III Study (Core Area)
- Lorton Visioning
- Typically 5-10 new site-specific Board authorizations per year
 - Affordable housing opportunities at county-owned sites
- Policy Plan Priority, Multi-year review

Lorton Area Study

- Planning Support: \$75,000-\$100,000
- Transportation Analysis: \$300,000
- Fairfax Center Area Study Phase III (Core Area)
 - Planning Support: \$75,000-\$100,000
 - Transportation Analysis: \$250,000

South County SSPA

• Planning/Outreach Support: \$50,000

Planning Support: \$200,000-\$250,000

Transportation Analysis: \$550,000
