Several'nonprofits expressed concern about some developers no longer offering corporate leases for their clients, who are often disabled or transitioning out of chronic homelessness. There was a discussion regarding the challenges and benefits of this type of lease especially as the rental market becomes more competitive.

Director's Report

Director Liberman informed the Commission that the Board Budget Mark-up is scheduled for April 23, 2013. The formal adoption of the FY 2014 budget is April 30, 2013.

Commissioner Geier-Smith did not have a report.

Staff Report

- The EPA added a business size <u>bed bug tip card</u> to their outreach material. The tip cards, which provide general information as well as tips for travelers, were distributed to Commissioners.
- Staff provided a summary of two cases mediated by staff. One case involved a dispute about a smoke free lease addendum. The second case involved a tenant who advertised a room for rent in the dwelling they rented from the landlord. Mediation and case details were provided.
