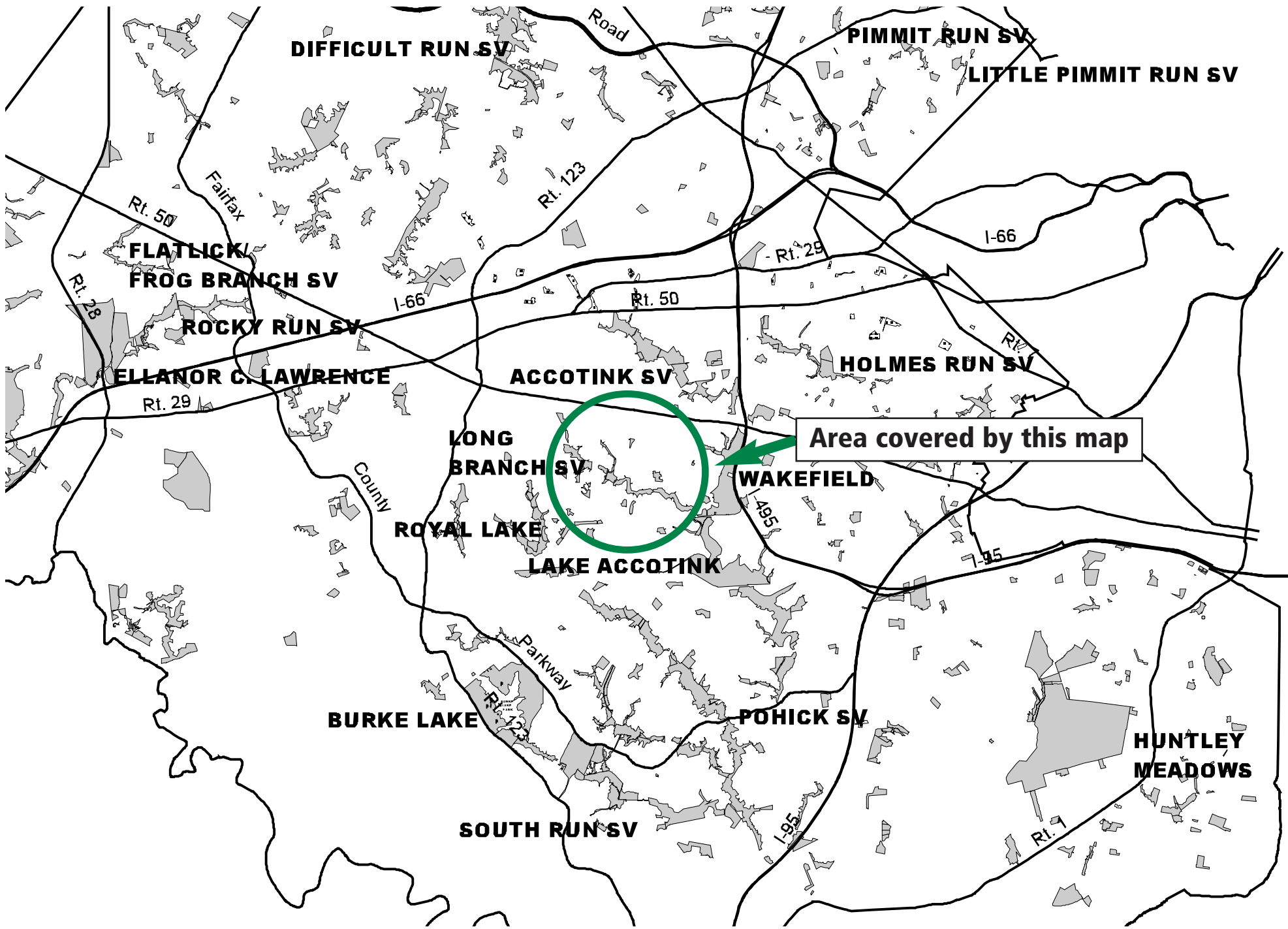


Long Branch Stream Valley Trail

to Olley Lane

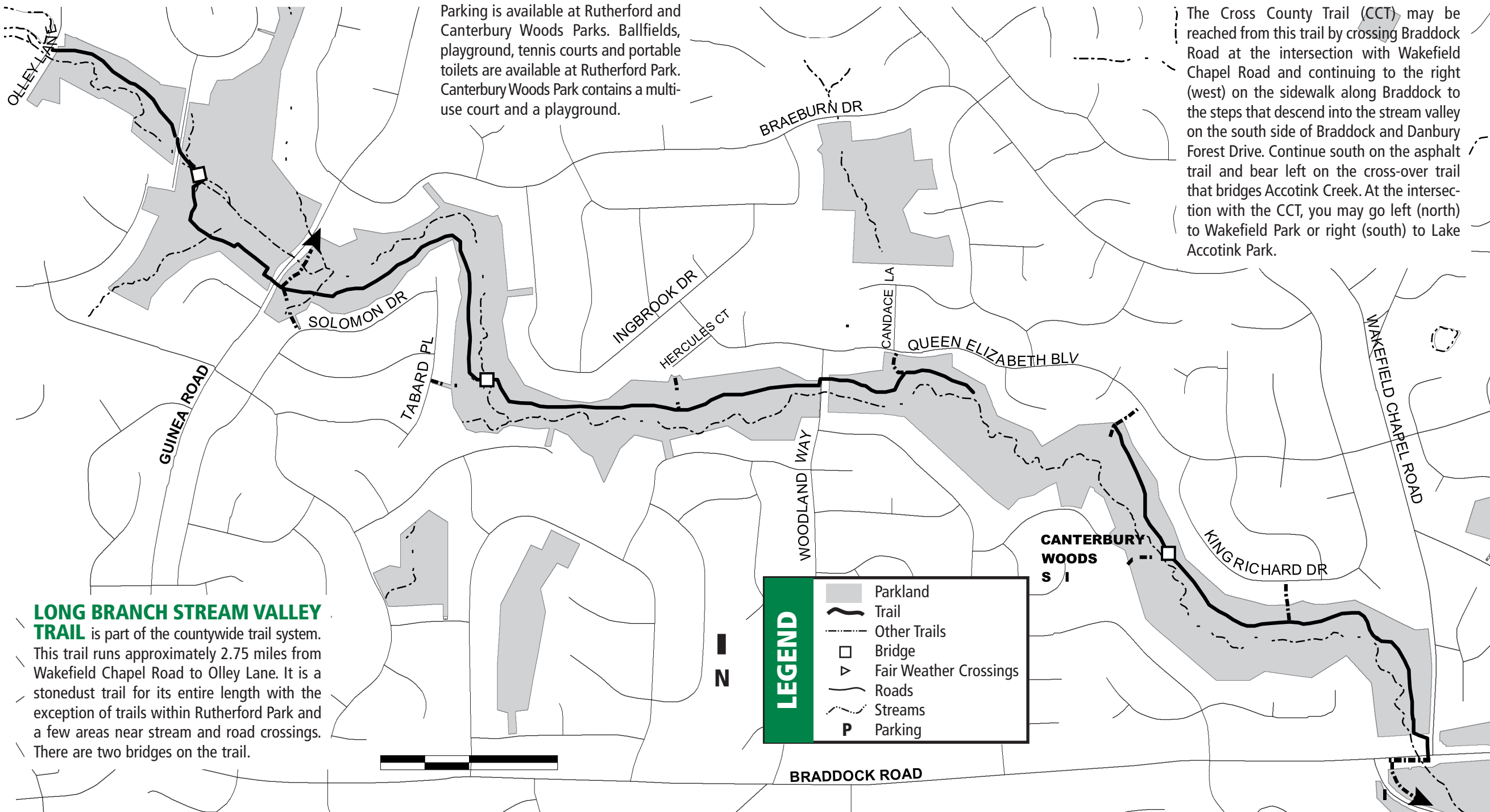


Parking is available at Rutherford and Canterbury Woods Parks. Ballfields, playground, tennis courts and portable toilets are available at Rutherford Park. Canterbury Woods Park contains a multi-use court and a playground.

The Cross County Trail (CCT) may be reached from this trail by crossing Braddock Road at the intersection with Wakefield Chapel Road and continuing to the right (west) on the sidewalk along Braddock to the steps that descend into the stream valley on the south side of Braddock and Danbury Forest Drive. Continue south on the asphalt trail and bear left on the cross-over trail that bridges Accotink Creek. At the intersection with the CCT, you may go left (north) to Wakefield Park or right (south) to Lake Accotink Park.

LONG BRANCH STREAM VALLEY TRAIL

is part of the countywide trail system. This trail runs approximately 2.75 miles from Wakefield Chapel Road to Olley Lane. It is a stonedust trail for its entire length with the exception of trails within Rutherford Park and a few areas near stream and road crossings. There are two bridges on the trail.
