

Property owners and managers are responsible for recycling and refuse collection, which are spelled out in Fairfax County's **Solid Waste Management Code Chapter 109.1**. Those responsibilities include:

- Providing a recycling system for residents to recycle cardboard and mixed paper.
- The refuse and recycling system must be of sufficient capacity so that there is no need for tenants to deposit material on the ground or put their recyclables in a refuse container. Selecting the proper size containers for managing recycling and refuse, and ensuring at least once-a-week collection, will address these issues.
- Any refuse container with a capacity of 2 cubic yards or greater must be accompanied by one or more recycling collection containers with a volume equal to or greater than 25% of the refuse container.
- Recycling collection containers must be clearly labeled with the materials that are accepted for recycling.
- All tenants must be notified about recycling program requirements upon occupancy and at least once a year thereafter.
- Areas around collection containers must be kept free of litter.
