Summary of Highlights from January to December 2009

Capital Program Highlights

- Eighteen (18) projects were completed in 2009. Six projects were completed in the last quarter of 2009: Route 28 Interchange at Frying Pan Road, Route 28 Interchange at Willard Road, Dolley Madison Boulevard @ Ingleside Ave, Route 236 @ Braddock Road EB, Route 236 @ Braddock Road WB, and Tuttle Road Trail.
- Ten projects are under construction: I-495 Capital Beltway HOT Lanes, I-95 Fourth-Lane Widening, Woodrow Wilson Bridge (includes Route 1 and Telegraph Road interchanges), Georgetown Pike/Walker Road, Centreville Road (West Ox Road to Frying Pan Road), Fairfax County Parkway EPG, South Kings Highway/Harrison Lane, Spring Hill Road, Dulles Rail (Phase I), West Falls Church Bus Canopy, and Lee Jackson Highway Walkway.

Innovative Project Design and Delivery

- Capital Beltway HOT Lanes PPTA The entire section of I-495 from the Springfield Interchange to just north of the Dulles Toll Road is under construction. Currently, 12 interchanges are under construction including bridge demolition, installation of steel and bridge decks, and utility relocation. Several sections of sounds walls are being installed throughout the 28 mile corridor (14 miles in each direction). Major traffic switches and/or lane closures have taken place at Braddock Road, Gallows Road, Arlington Boulevard, Lee Highway, I-66, Oak Street, and Route 123 interchanges/overpasses. Recently, the exit ramp lanes on I-495 north to Arlington Boulevard have been shifted to a new bridge. For further information, <u>www.VAmegaprojects.com</u>
- Route 28 PPTA Construction is substantially complete on the "final four" interchanges: Route 28/Innovation (partial interchange), Route 28/Willard Road and Route 28/Frying Pan Road (Fairfax County), and Route 28/Nokes Blvd (Loudoun County). In July 2009, funding was authorized for design only to widen three segments: SB Sterling Blvd to Dulles Toll Road, NB McLearen Road to Dulles Toll Road, and SB Dulles Toll Road to Route 50.

Dulles Rail

- Construction activities are underway along the entire alignment of Phase 1. The ramp that connects southbound Route 123 to Route 7 is open to westbound Route 7 traffic only. This new pattern will be in effect for approximately three years. Along Route 7, mid-block left turns are being removed. Left turns into the Marshalls shopping center have been eliminated. Construction includes night work along roads leading to Route 7 and ramp closings at the Route 7 and Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) interchange. Retaining walls are being built near Pike 7 Plaza on the south side of Route 7. For further information, <u>http://www.dullesmetro.com/</u>
- The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is funding the new Tysons Connector shuttle bus service that will provide free rides to and from office buildings, condos and apartments, Tysons Corner Center and Tysons Galleria. The service began in late November 2009, and is operated by the Fairfax Connector bus system.

Special Programs Highlights

Pedestrian Program

- **Pedestrian Projects:** The Board has directed FCDOT to lead the \$58 million effort of constructing pedestrian improvements in high-priority areas of Fairfax County. Pedestrian intersection improvements were completed along Route 29, Route 50 and the Fairfax County Parkway. Pedestrian intersection improvements are under construction along Route 7 (three locations), Route 50, Route 123 and Route 236. Additionally, over 100 pedestrian projects and over 100 bus stop projects are currently under design.
- **Countdown Pedestrian Signals:** Fairfax County has more modern countdown signals installed than any other jurisdiction in Virginia. FCDOT initially funded VDOT for the upgrade of 150 locations. VDOT continued upgrading with state funding so that now nearly all of the 500 intersections with signalized crosswalks in Fairfax County have these improved LED signals, which aid drivers and pedestrians in understanding the "Don't Walk" time remaining to cross.
- I-495 HOT Lanes Project: Pedestrian and bicycle facilities are being constructed on all of the bridges in the I-495 HOT Lanes Project. These new facilities will remove some of the worst barriers to pedestrian and bicycle movement in Fairfax County, since most of the existing bridges have no pedestrian facilities.
- **StreetSmart:** Supervisor Gross was the lead official speaker at the Spring 2009 kick-off media event for StreetSmart, the pedestrian safety and awareness campaign conducted by MWCOG for regionally coordinated pedestrian safety education and enforcement. As part of the StreetSmart campaign, FCDOT staff installed pedestrian safety posters at bus shelters throughout the County, and installed pedestrian safety bus cards in all Fairfax Connector buses.
- **Pedestrian Lighting:** In coordination with DPWES, FCDOT continues to implement priority roadway lighting as a component of the Pedestrian Program. Initial project locations include Metro station areas, Route 1, and pedestrian safety improvements, such as Oakwood Road near the Van Dorn Metro.
- Yield to Pedestrians Program: The "Yield to Pedestrians in Crosswalks \$100 \$500 Violation Fine" Signs Program is administered by FCDOT. Currently FCDOT has installed and maintains over 1,800 of these signs at 455 intersections in the County.

Bicycle Program

- On-Road Bike Lane Initiative: Six miles of on-road bike lanes were completed in summer 2009. Work is continuing on additional roadway segments including: Westmoreland Street Phase II, Hunter Village Drive, and Gallows Road Phase II. New segments will include: Sleepy Hollow Road (Mason District), Fort Hunt Road (Mount Vernon District), and Huntington Avenue (Lee District). This is a cooperative program between FCDOT and VDOT.
- **County Bicycle Parking Policy and Guidelines**: Staff is completing work on the development of the County bicycle parking standards. This document will provide guidance to both the development community and governmental agencies responsible for the design, installation and maintenance of bicycle racks and facilities. It will also define parking ratios based on land uses.

Summary of Highlights from January to December 2009

- Increase and Enhance Bicycle Parking: 150 bicycle racks were purchased and delivered in December 2009. The racks are the inverted "U" style rack and will be installed at locations countywide including the Town of Vienna and Town of Herndon. Staff is currently preparing a bid document for the purchase of 40 new bicycle lockers.
- Vienna Metro-City of Fairfax-GMU Connector: Work has begun on a bicycle route connecting GMU with Vienna Metro via the City of Fairfax. This is a cooperative project with the City, GMU, and the NVRPA.
- Metrorail Station Area Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements Study: Beginning in July with a public information meeting, WMATA has retained a consultant to undertake a study of bicycle and pedestrian deficiencies and needs at the region's Metrorail stations. Two stations in Fairfax County were chosen as part of this study; Vienna and Huntington. This study will identify bicycle parking needs, access improvements, and safety. This study is being managed by WMATA in coordination with FCDOT, DPZ, and other stakeholders. This study should be completed in the first quarter of 2010.
- **Bike the Sites Map:** FCDOT was awarded a transportation enhancement grant for FY2010 to complete a bicycle map that highlights a route along historic Civil War sites in Fairfax County. This allocation will also fund the installation of wayfinding signage and interpretive markers along the bicycle route. Federal approval to initiate this work is anticipated in February 2010.
- **Bicycle Master Plan Study:** As requested by the Board, staff is developing recommendations for conducting a Bicycle Master Plan Study. The study will be phased with the first segment focusing on the Tysons Corner area. Work is anticipated to begin in March 2010.
- **Bicycle Route Signage-Dranesville District:** Staff is currently preparing sign plans for bike routes in three locations in the Dranesville District.

Traffic Calming Program

- Nine traffic calming projects were initiated for study.
- Three projects were approved by the Board and were forwarded to VDOT for installation.

Transportation Demand Management (TDM) and Mixed-Use Development

- The County has integrated Transportation Demand Management (TDM) strategies into the land development process and is working to formalize this program. TDM proffers promote alternatives to single occupant vehicle trips. These proffers contain commitments to provide TDM services, goals for percentage trip reduction, and remedies or penalties for non-attainment of proffered goals. The TDM proffer coordinator is negotiating proffers and monitoring implementation and performance of existing proffers.
- A consultant study on integrating TDM into the land use and approval process is progressing. Local data collection to quantify possible TDM reductions was completed in summer 2009. Preliminary recommendations on TDM reductions and parking strategies for transit-oriented development were subsequently reviewed by a steering committee. This winter, the study and recommendations will be completed, and discussed in one or more public presentations. If adopted, the study recommendations will lead to more effective TDM strategies and formalized arrangements for TDM proffers.

Summary of Highlights from January to December 2009

• Preliminary findings from the TDM study were used to inform staff recommendations for the TDM and Parking sections of the draft Comprehensive Plan text prepared for the Tyson's Corner Committee of the Planning Commission.

Bus Stop Safety and Access (Bus Stop Improvement Program)

- Fairfax County places a priority on providing safe access to efficient transportation options including pedestrian amenities and transit service. A comprehensive inventory and study of all bus stops in Fairfax County identified undesirable bus stop conditions for priority action. The Board has identified \$2.5 million from the general fund and \$7.75 million in the 2007 Transportation Bond for improvements to the priority stops identified in the study.
- 44 sites have been completed since implementing the program. There are currently 23 sites in project development, 125 in design, 12 in land acquisition and 19 under construction.

Bus Shelter Advertising Program

 FCDOT intends to engage in a public/private partnership to aid in the improvement of bus stops, which is expected to raise revenues through the sale of advertising space on bus shelters. A solicitation has been made for bids to construct, maintain, and operate bus shelters within the County. The contractor will sell advertising space to subsidize construction, maintenance, and operation of the shelters, and will share a percentage of the surplus revenues with the County. The Bus Shelter Program bids were received in October 2009.

Fleet Expansion and Replacement of Older Buses with Cleaner Buses

- Fairfax Connector is committed to improving its fleet of passenger vehicles. Fairfax Connector has added 107 new transit vehicles to date with "Clean Diesel" buses, which are low-floor and more easily accessible than the older vehicles.
- Twenty-four older buses have been re-built so that additional service life can be realized.
- Fairfax Connector will be placing two orders for an additional 30 "Clean Diesel" low-floor buses for delivery in late 2009/early 2010. Thirteen buses are for fleet replacements and the balance are planned for implementing high priority service.

Conversion of Metrobus to Fairfax Connector in Western Fairfax

- Service began on Monday, June 29, 2009, with Fairfax Connector's new service provider, MV Contract Transportation, Inc.
- Due to passenger demand, additional trips were added in August 2009; staff is proposing to add more service to the Stone Road Park and Ride in January 2010.

West Ox Bus Operations Center

• The County's West Ox Bus Operations Center is in full operation as of late June 2009 with revenue service being operated by both the County's Fairfax Connector bus service and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority's Metrobus service.

SPOT Transportation (Special Populations Transportation)

• Seniors On-The-Go! and TaxiAccess are two user-side subsidy taxicab programs managed by FCDOT's Special Populations Transportation programs (SPOT).

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- From October 1st to December 14th, the Seniors On-the-Go! registered 34 new participants, for a cumulative total of 4,882 registrants since the program's inception in 2001. 650 coupon booklets were sold during this period with a street value of \$ 21,450.
- TaxiAccess registered 15 new participants in the same time period, for a cumulative total of 541 registrants since the program's inception in 2007. 227 coupon booklets were sold, with a street value of \$ 7,491.
- The SPOT staff also continued distribution of free Senior SmarTrip cards to older adults for use on the local fixed route transit system (bus and rail). Since the beginning of the distribution, Senior SmarTrip cards have been distributed free to over 570 seniors.

Telework and Outreach

- The Fairfax County government telework program currently has 1,332 employee participants, and continues to encourage teleworking countywide.
- The Fairfax County Employer Services Program (FCESP) partners with major employers, developers and multi-family complexes to promote and encourage alternative commute options. To date, 202 Fairfax County employers have implemented a Level 3 or 4 transportation benefits program, and another 176 employers have implemented a Level 1 or 2 program. Level 1 and 2 programs may include commuter surveys and/or supplying data for a commuter/employee density plot, distributing transit information, implementing alternative work schedules, or hosting an on-site transportation fair. Level 3 and 4 programs may include shuttles to/from transit stations, implementing formal telework programs, offering transit subsidies, providing free or premium parking to carpools and vanpools, or implementing a comprehensive bike/walk program.
- The FCESP is also supporting the Congestion Mitigation Program for Dulles Rail and HOT Lanes construction by coordinating employer and community outreach with regional partners, including VDRPT, VDOT, DATA and TyTran.
- The FCESP also partners with a consultant to review and make recommendations on TDM proffers from developers.

Transit Development Plan (TDP) Activities

- FCDOT and consultant staff presented draft final recommendations, including a more detailed service plan for Tysons Corner bus service upon the opening of Phase 1 of the Metrorail Silver Line, to County boards and commissions, several business and community groups, and the general public. Consultant staff completed final recommendations including implementation plan for presentation to the Board in early 2010.
- Consultant staff continued work on several ancillary tasks to review Fairfax Connector public information materials and methods of presentation and transmission.

Transit Studies

 In conjunction with planning for the I-95/I-395 HOT Lanes Project, an I-95/I-395 HOV/HOT Lanes Transit/TDM Study was initiated in 2007 at the request of the Secretary of Transportation, managed by DRPT. Staff is currently working with the project team to develop park and ride and transit facilities in the corridor in fulfillment of the HOT lane project commitments.

Summary of Highlights from January to December 2009

- An I-66 Corridor Transit/TDM Study to optimize short-term corridor bus transit service and define elements of potential Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) service was initiated in summer 2008. The study was completed and a Draft Final Report issued in December 2009. Staff is currently working with the State and advisory group to develop short and medium term transit service and facility recommendations for the corridor.
- VDOT and DRPT were asked in early 2008 to restart the process for the I-66 Multi-Modal EIS outside the Beltway. The EIS should address all potential integrated facilities and operations anticipated over the next 25-30 years-plus, and funding for implementation.
- In 2008, a transit circulator study for the Springfield activity center was completed as an element of the Springfield Connectivity Study. A transit circulator study for the Tyson's Corner Urban Center began in summer 2009 in conjunction with replanning efforts underway for Tyson's.

Safety, Traffic Flow, Signals, and Congestion Management

- A Traffic Management Plan (TMP) is underway for the Capital Beltway HOT Lanes and other Northern Virginia Megaprojects to reduce congestion during construction. This includes incentives to reduce demand and promote alternative travel modes. In late November 2009, the Tysons Connector midday free lunch shuttle began service in and around Tysons Corner. Motorists can now view real time traffic information, bus schedules, and construction activities via the Traveler Information Displays installed throughout Tysons Corner. The Megaprojects Employer Solutions team is actively meeting with employers to promote commuter solutions including Telework.
- Real time freeway monitoring system for Interstates 66, 395 and 95: Application has been deployed and is in daily use. Supplemental tools in use include the NCR's regional integrated transportation information system (RITIS); and, the I-95 Corridor Coalition's INRIX travel time protocol.
- VDOT has implemented an innovative traffic management system called **Variable Speed Limit** (VSL) to assist drivers approaching the reconstruction of the Telegraph Road interchange, as a part of the Woodrow Wilson Bridge project. VSL has been operational since July 28, 2008. VDOT has re-evaluated the algorithm and has expanded the use of VSL for peak hours, incident management and weather incidents.
- In conjunction with a planned repaving project, a "road diet" was implemented on 2-mile section of **Lawyers Road east of Reston Parkway**. The street was remarked from two lanes in each direction to one lane and a bicycle lane in each direction, separated by a center turning lane. The change is expected to significantly improve safety. Minor pavement marking changes were implemented on four other roadways in Fairfax County as well.
- VDOT has studied intersections for signals, signage, marking and traffic control devices and recommended improvements at various locations.

Incident Management

- VDOT Regional Operations continues to work with the Virginia State Police and Fairfax County Police regarding quick clearance protocol, and has recently engaged Fire Chief Rohr on this matter also.
- For emergency response, VDOT has initiated a Duty Officer construct which requires executive management personnel to be on call for highway, weather, and planned

incidents . Depending on the nature of an incident, the Duty Officer may initiate a VDOT incident command at PSTOC, which includes representation from VSP, VDOT maintenance, operations, and public affairs as well as coordination with Fairfax County Police and Fire.

- Incident Management Task Group (Fairfax County Police, Fire and Rescue, Virginia State Police and towing companies): Starting January 2010, VDOT Regional Operations will re-initiate a monthly first responder coordination meeting at PSTOC to review highway incidents and identify improvement opportunities. The incident management task group will continue, and ultimately be merged with the monthly meeting.
- **Comprehensive evacuation plans:** VDOT Regional Operations is providing technical assistance and support to VDEM who are the recipient of a UASI Grant of approximately \$1.5M to investigate emergency evacuation on the NOVA arterial network. This work is a follow-on to that completed for Routes 50 and 1. The objective is to identify appropriate traffic signal strategies. Work is just getting underway as of December 2009.
- **PSTOC and 911:** A December 2009 'introduction' meeting was held with VDOT Regional Operations at PSTOC that included Fairfax County Fire and Rescue, Fairfax County Police, Fairfax County 911, and VSP managers to begin the process of coordination on matters such as highway incidents, weather incidents, and planned events. Since the 911, Police, and Fire Dispatch groups have only been in the PSTOC a few months, it is expected that there will be continued efforts to institutionalize activities.

Other Projects

Rail

• **AF to RW Third Track Reconstruction Project:** VDRPT, VRE, and CSX, working with Amtrak and the Federal Railroad Administration, identified six projects to increase passenger rail capacity and reliability between Richmond and Washington, D.C. Five of the six projects are complete, and the final project is underway. This project will construct seven miles of third main line track north of the Franconia-Springfield VRE station and add signal system components. Construction is expected to be complete by spring 2010.
